PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Fred Hutch/Shoreline Community College Lab Tech Certificate Program program is a comprehensive 2-year summer internship for rising seniors in high school integrated with their learning. This program will provide cohorts of 10-12 students annually with lab skills and complementary academic training required for research and clinical lab technical positions across Fred Hutch. There are two components to the program:

- Lab technical skills training Paid 2-summer internship at Fred Hutch where students will be hosted in a laboratory and trained to perform laboratory technical procedures.
- Academic training Enrollment at Shoreline College for the Fred Hutch/Shoreline Community College Lab
 Tech Certificate Program. This portion of the program will commence after the first summer of technical
 training and continue after the second summer of lab skills training.

The first summer of lab skills training will run from **July 5th 2023**, **to August 16th 2023**. Students must be able to commit to the entire period to participate.

The application will close at **11:59pm on March 31st**, **2023**. Requests for letters of recommendation will be sent to recommenders as soon as the student portion of the application is submitted. Letters of recommendations must be submitted by **11:59pm on April 14th**, **2023**. Last-minute technical issues will not be considered exceptions to this deadline. Please apply early.

ELIGIBILITY

Students should...

- Be a minimum of 17 years old by June 15 of 2023
- Be entering senior year of high school in Fall 2023 or equivalent (Running Start)
- · Be interested in the biological sciences
- Not be intending to immediately attend a four-year college, or not wish to to attend a four-year college at all

This program is **specifically designed for students from backgrounds historically underrepresented in science**. This includes individuals from underrepresented races/ethnicities, individuals with disabilities, and individuals from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.


