

Seattle SCAN Study

- Seattle Coronavirus Assessment Network— coronavirus surveillance study collecting nasal swabs (daily cap ~300) from a volunteer sample of people across Seattle (sampling based on Public Use Microdata Areas)
 - Online signup, swab delivered to you for self-collection; return to lab
 - Launched 3/23; 2075 kits sent so far
- Assess prevalence (particularly asymptomatics), severity, distribution of disease; assess impacts of closures/distancing
- Assess trends in geography, in time, and demographically (age, sex)
- Inform PHSKC contact tracing and control efforts
- Primarily descriptive methods; data will be useful in informing modelling efforts (validate predictions?)
- Student Involvement: some medical students involved, none in biostat that I am aware of
