# **Getting Started**

## What is peer-to-peer fundraising?

Peer-to-peer fundraising allows you to plan and design your own fundraiser and ask your friends, family, and community to donate directly to the organization you're supporting. It's like being a team captain for a good cause, using your voice and connections to make a big impact!

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#### **How It Works At Fred Hutch**



**Step 1:** Pick an activity you'd like to organize to fundraise for Fred Hutch. It can be a bake sale, bike ride, art auction, dance party, or anything else you dream up!



**Step 2:** <u>Set up your personal fundraising page</u> and customize it with your story, photos, and fundraising goal.



**Step 3**: Spread the word through social media, emails, flyers, and text messages to ask your friends and family to support your fundraiser. We've included tools, below, to help you!

Every dollar you raise helps researchers at Fred Hutch advance groundbreaking ideas and find new ways to prevent, detect, and treat cancer and infectious disease.

## **Planning Your Fundraiser**

- Set a goal: How much do you want to raise? Be ambitious!
- Decide on a timeline: Pick start and end dates for fundraising.
- Build your team: Invite friends, family, classmates or neighbors to support your fundraiser — whether by donating, volunteering or contributing goods or services.



# **Setting Up Your Fundraising Page**

Fred Hutch makes it easy! Start to build your fundraising page <u>here</u>.

- 1. Visit <u>fredhutch.org/fundraise</u>
- 2. Choose the "Create a New Fundraiser" button
- 3. Choose your fundraiser type:
  - a. In honor of someone or a special occasion
- 4. Choose individual or team fundraiser
  - a. Choose the individual option if you only want one fundraising page for your event.
  - b. Choose the team option if you want others to be able to create their own fundraising pages for your event. **Note:** For **memorial fundraisers**, only the individual option is available—team fundraising is an option.
- 5. Fundraise for the specific disease or area of research that matters to you most
  - a. When you register, you can select which disease or area of research you want to support with the funds you raise. Alternatively, you can select Fred Hutch Greatest Need to provide flexible funding for emerging or time-sensitive research needs.

# Tips For Creating a Successful Fundraising Page

**Share your story:** Tell people why you're fundraising for Fred Hutch. Whether it's in honor or memory of someone special, a personal connection to cancer research, or simply wanting to help others, your story makes the cause real and relatable.

Add photos and videos: Visuals make your page more engaging and personal. A photo of you in action — baking, biking, or creating art — can make a big difference. You can even make a short video to post on your page!

## Tips for Talking About Your Fundraiser in Person

- Start with your why: Share your personal reason for fundraising whether it's honoring someone, fueling science, or making a difference.
- Be confident: You're giving people a chance to support you and something you are passionate about. That's powerful!
- Keep it simple: "I'm raising money for Fred Hutch to accelerate cancer research. Would you consider donating or sharing my page?"
- Practice your pitch: Try it out with friends or family first.
- **Use visuals:** Bring a flyer or show your fundraising page on your phone.
- Follow up: People appreciate reminders. Don't be afraid to ask more than once.

- Set up a lemonade stand
- Organize a "dress down day" at school
- Run a gaming for good event (livestream or tournament)
- Have an art auction or talent show
- Set up a birthday fundraiser
